Educational Assistance for CSU Employees

Looking to further your education this fall?

- **Educational Assistance Award**
 - State classified employees seeking to move ahead in their jobs/careers can apply for this award to help offset associated costs.
 - Five awards will be given to employees demonstrating need in the amount of \$500 (less taxes) and can be used for expenses such as tuition, books, child care expenses, gas for traveling to class, etc.
